سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ

100 times = 1,000 Good Deeds Recorded

OR

100 times = 1,000 Bad Deeds Erased

Sa'd bin Abu Waqqas (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: We were with the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) when he asked, "Is anyone of you unable to earn a thousand good deeds?" One of those present asked: "How can one earn a thousand good deeds in a day?" He (ﷺ) replied, "By saying:

SubhanAllah a hundred times, then one thousand good deeds will be recorded for him or one thousand sins will be blotted out from his record." [Muslim].

Astagh-fe-rullah- wa-a-toobu-illay

I seek Allah's forgiveness and I repent to Him.

Narrated Abu Huraira: I heard Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) saying:

"By Allah! I ask for forgiveness from Allah and turn to Him in repentance more than seventy times a day."

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ

وَ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ

SubhanAllah, Walhamdu lillah, Wa la illaha illah allah, Wallahu Akbar.

Glorified is Allah (SWT), and all praise and thanks is for Allah (SWT), and there is no one worthy of worship except Allah (SWT), and Allah (SWT) is the Greatest.

Abu Huraira reported Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) as saying: The uttering of (these words):

"Subhaanallaahi, walhamdu lillaahi, wa laa 'laaha 'illallaahu wallaahu 'Akbar"

is dearer to me than anything over which the sun rises.

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ وَسَلِّمْ وَبَارِكْ عَلَى سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ

Allahuma Sully, wasallim, wabarik 'ala sayidina Muhammad

Oh Allah, send your peace and blessings on the Prophet Muhammad

It was narrated that Abdullah ibn Mas'ood (may Allah be pleased with him) said:

The Messenger of Allah (SAW) said:

"Allah has angels who go around on earth, conveying to me the salaam of my ummah."

[Sunan Nasaa'i, Saheeh Al-Albani]

"There is not one of you who sends his greetings upon me except that Allah returns the soul to my body (in the grave) and I return his greeting."

[Abu Dawood, Saheeh Al-Albani]

Abdullah bin 'Amr bin Al-'As (May Allah be pleased with them) reported: I heard the Messenger of Allah sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam saying:

"Whoever supplicates Allah to exalt my mention (i.e., send salah), Allah will exalt his mention (i.e., send salah) ten times and remove from him ten sins and raise him ten degrees."

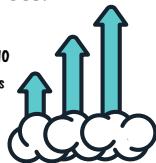

Glorified is God and Praised is He, Glorified is God, the Greatest

Our Prophet Muhammad (SAW) said:

"These are two statements that are light for the tongue to remember, heavy in the scales and are dear to the Merciful"

لَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ

La hawla wa la qu-wata illa billah

There is no power or might except (by) Allah.

Abu Musa Ash'ari reported that Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said to him:

Should I not direct you to the words from the treasures of Paradise, or he said: Like a treasure from the treasures of Paradise? I said: Of course, do that. Thereupon he said:

"There is no might and no power but that of Allah."

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ لَهُ الْمُلْكُ
وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

La illaha illa Allah, wah-da-hoo, la sha-ree-ka lah, lahul mulk, wa-la-hul hamd, wa-hu-wa 'ala kully shay-in qadeer

There is no one worthy of worship except Allah alone, without partner. His is the dominion and all praise is His, and He is able to do all things.

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "He who utters a hundred times in a day these words: 'La illaha illa Allah, wah-da-hoo, la sha-ree-ka lah, lahul mulk, wa-la-hul hamd, wa-hu-wa 'ala kully shay-in qadeer (there is no true god except Allah. He is One and He has no partner with Him; His is the sovereignty and His is the praise, and He is Omnipotent [All-Powerful]),'

he will have a reward equivalent to that for emancipating ten slaves,

a hundred good deeds will be recorded to his credit, a hundred of his sins will be blotted out from his scroll, and he will be safeguarded against the devil on that day till the evening;

and no one will exceed him in doing more excellent good deeds except someone who has recited these words more often than him.

SubhanAllahy wa-be-hamdih

Glorified is God and praised is He,

...And he who utters: 'SubhanAllahy wa-be-hamdih (Allah is free from imperfection and His is the praise)'

one hundred times a day, his sins will be obliterated even if they are equal to the extent of the foam of the ocean."
